 - Cell phone (85%) and Landline (14%)



How often do you wear your seatbelt? "% All of the time"










Figure 5. TICKET, 2015 to 2019







Figure 11c. CLICKSEE by Age (55+ year olds), 2015 to 2019



Figure 11a. CLICKSEE by Age (18-34 year olds), 2015 to 2019





CIOT Awareness by Home Language Spoken








